

Ride Details

Enjoy the splendid beauty of the country fresh air in the Arcadia area as you bike the scenic hills and valleys. You will see one of the most beautiful overlooks in Wisconsin during the medium and long tours. The ride will be held on Saturday, May 29th, starting in Memorial Park. You can park your car in the Aquatic Center Parking Lot and follow the signs past the Kids Kingdom Playground to the registration area. Restrooms are available in the nearby Pavilion.

You may select the length of tour which suits your style. There will be five choices of lengths of rides:

They range from 10 miles to 60+ miles with the long tour being a metric century with a mile high of cumulative climbing. This route is a great challenge for those cyclists who like to test their abilities.
